Are you interested in becoming a swimming official?

At each of our home galas we require at least 18 qualified officials to run the gala and ensure that we have enough officials to meet the requirements for the licence that is granted to us by Swim England.

We do not have enough of our own officials and therefore rely on officials from other clubs coming to help this means as a club we incur expenses, which reduces the amount of money that we make at the gala. Gala income helps us as a club to survive, therefore ideally, we need to be able to run the gala with as many of our own officials as possible!

The first qualification (Judge Level 1) involves some online training followed by poolside sessions which can be carried out at a range of galas (including our home galas). If you would like some more information, then please contact Gillian on the following email address.
